

NEW DELHI: With the Gandhis engaging with G-23 leaders after their recent offensive in the wake of the party's poll debacle, some may find a place in the decision-making process in the revamped Congress in line with their demand for collective leadership. Sources said some

leaders may be accommodated in the CWC or in a new body like the Parliamentary Board, which the G23 had suggested for taking all policy decisions including finalising chief ministerial candidates and tie-ups with like-minded parties in states.



Situation along LoC stable: Govt



NEW DELHI: The situation along the Line of Control remains stable after the armies of India and Pakistan agreed to observe a ceasefire in February last year, the defence ministry said on Monday.



Minister of State for Defence Ajay Bhatt, replying to a question in Rajya Sabha, said the Army has been keeping a strong vigil on the situation and it remains prepared to thwart any threat from "inimical elements".

In a sudden and significant move aimed at reducing tensions, the Indian and Pakistani armies on February 25 last year announced they would cease firing across the LoC while recommitting themselves to a 2003 ceasefire agreement. Without mentioning Pakistan, he said Indian security forces deployed along the western borders are "adequately

poised to respond to any challenge posed by adversary across the entire conflict". Referring to the international border (IB) with Pakistan, Bhatt said there are indications of an "emerging narco-terror nexus sponsored by inimical elements across the border".

"The situation along Line of Control remains stable post the Directorate General of Military Operations (DG-MOs) understanding of February 2021," Bhatt said.

Withhold funds if DISHA committee meeting is not held regularly: Adhir

Congress' leader in Lok Sabha Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury urged the government to bring in a provision for withholding of funds if a district development coordination and monitoring committee (DISHA) does not regularly hold its meetings in states.



Several members cutting across the party line supported Chowdhury's suggestion with thumping of desk as he raised the issue in the Lower House during Question Hour, complaining that meeting of the DISHA committee in his district in West Bengal has not been held for several years. He said Lok Sabha members can seek all information from DISHA committee and ask questions relating to implementation of various schemes and programmes in their respective district. "Despite pleading for it in this House again and again, no meeting of the DISHA committee has been called in my district for last 12-13 years, even as I am its chairman," Chowdhury said.

Appropriation bills back in LS

Rajya Sabha on Monday returned a money bill moved by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, authorising the government for payment and appropriation of certain sums from the consolidated fund for the financial year 2021-22. The Upper House also returned another Appropriation Bill for the expenditure done in the 2018-19 financial year. Both the Appropriation Bills were passed by Lok Sabha earlier.

New Parl building project 'achieves' 44% progress

The new Parliament building project, which has its deadline in October, has achieved 44 per cent physical progress, and the government has so far spent Rs480 crore on it, the Rajya Sabha was informed on Monday. The government has plans to hold the winter session in the new Parliament building this year. In reply to a written question, Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs Kaushal Kishore said the government is likely to spend Rs2,285 crore on the entire Central Vista project in the next financial year.
